HOW DO I BECOME TEAM MEMBER?

All team members must complete an application form detailing their contact details, past experiences and qualifications. They will also require:

- A DBS check if not already undertaken by LEBC
- Two references of which one should be from outside LEBC
- To attend or have attended Child Protection Training and understood the LEBC safe guarding policy
- If in the kitchen team, to have a level 2 food safety training certificate
- ▶ If possible, but not essential, to have a first aid certificate

Training will be provided where required and a full briefing for all team members will be held before the first session takes place.

CAN I JUST BE A HELPER?

- We actively encourage anyone over the age of 16yrs to be a helper at any session. Helpers will be be under the supervision of a team member at all times.
- Helpers over 18yrs will be subject to a DBS check.
- Helpers will be required to attend an informal interview with the make lunch coordinator before they help at a session.

CAN I BE A PART OF MAKE LUNCH AND BRING MY OWN FAMILY ALONG?

It would be great to have as many of our Church Family involved in Make Lunch as possible.

Unfortunately team members are unable to bring along their own family to a Make Lunch session.
