QUIET ZONE

Read Luke 1:26-38

Think about what the angel told Mary about her son.

- How do you think Mary might have felt?



After the angel spoke to her Mary said

"I am the Lord's servant! Let it happen as you have said."

- Think about what it meant for Mary to be God's servant. Talk about it with an adult you live with

CREATIVE ZONE

Mary really trusted God even though she might have been frightened of what He had asked her to do. Sometimes we can have little sayings to help us to remember God in everyday. WWJD stands for What Would Jesus Do?, PUSH - Pray Until Something Happens and FROG is Fully Reliant On God.

Mary reacted to being pregnant with Jesus by praising God. Basically she burst into her very own song of worship. You can read it in Luke 1:46-55

DIGGING DEEPER ZONE

Read Luke 1:26-38.

Mary was a teenager when all of this happened, she may have been as young as 13

- How do you think Mary would have felt, firstly just to be visited by an angel and then told that she was going to have a baby
- The passage says that Mary was "greatly troubled". What do you think would have been worrying her?
- If God asked you to do something really huge, would you find it easy to react like Mary did and say you'll do whatever he asks?
- Would you set any limits on what you'd be willing to do?
