

Now you have your seeds it is time to grow them!

You will need: a container (flower pot, recycled yoghurt pot...etc) small stones, some soil or compost.

- Using scissors make some holes in the base of the pot and cover with small stones. This allows excess water to drain out.
- Fill with soil / compost to about 5 cm from top
- Place one seed in each small container (more if using a larger container.)
- Cover seeds with soil / compost.
- Water well. Sit container on a sunny windowsill.
- Keep soil damp but not soaking wet.
- Once plant reaches 12 to 15 cm you can plant out in the garden. Protect from pests and keep well watered.

Use the log on the other side to record the height and any observations/funny features. Measure from the soil to the topmost part of the plant in inches or cm.



Judging will occur on Sunday the 19th of September. Bring your record sheet and a photo (if possible) of your plants to Lower Earley Baptist Church from 2-3pm.
